The programme concludes with all groups pitching their ideas to a panel of experts and receiving a certificate to acknowledge their participation in the camp.

The camp provides students with the opportunity to think outside the box, problem solve, think critically and to explore ideas, to name a few. The skills learned over the five days not only allow students to explore different ways of thinking but it provides them with a set of skills they can apply to their school and project work.
